- ☆ What is our vision of Talmud Torah at Kehilat Gesher?
- ☆ We wish to provide our students with a liberal Jewish education which transmits values as much as knowledge.
- ☆ We want to teach young people to be comfortable with their Jewish identity no matter where they may be - France, the US, Israel, or anywhere else in the world. We want to offer this possibility in both French and in English.
- ☆ We are constructing a Talmud Torah based on the principals of tolerance and openness: all are welcome no matter their level of observance, their amount of previous religious education or their personal history.
- ☆ We offer a hard-working yet playful atmosphere where children can learn and have fun.
- ☆ We are building a Talmud Torah that is not simply one more class added to the children's already busy schedules, but a way to be connected to a lively community where they can explore their Jewish identities.
- ☆ We offer a Judaism steeped in tradition but also open to questioning and to history, two things necessary in order to understand how tradition evolves.
- ☆ Finally, we are creating a Talmud Torah where the teaching of Hebrew is important, as the language is one of the key elements to understanding and integrating Jewish culture.
